Master Adviser

The Master Adviser program recognizes outstanding advisers who operate co-curricular chapters with a balanced program of work. The application is available at www.mifccla.org, and is due by February 1.

Adviser Mentor

The Adviser Mentor program recognizes advisers who have achieved the level of Master Adviser and have worked with beginning advisers to orient them to Family, Career and Community Leaders of America. The application can be found at www.mifccla.org, and is due by February 1.

Spirit of Advising

The Spirit of Advising award recognizes advisers who have gone above and beyond in serving the state association. The state adviser selects this recipient each year.

Sandra Smith Adviser of the Year

The Sandra Smith Adviser of the Year Award is designed for *members* to nominate their adviser for outstanding service to their local school or chapter. Information regarding this process is sent to chapter officers in January.
